PROCEEDINGS of the BOARD of GUARDIANS as LOCAL AUTHORITY under the CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (ANIMALS) ACTS, 1878 to 1890.

1/1932/96. } From the Privy Council acknowledging the receipt of resolution of the Local Authority on the 3rd instant, relative to supposed cases of Rabies on the premises of Messrs Hanagan, Donnellan and Burke, stating that the matter is one for the exercise of the discretion of the Local Authority themselves.

The Local Authority are empowered by Article 14 (1) of the Rabies (Ireland) Order of 1895 to cause the slaughter of any suspected animal and to pay compensation to the owner out of the Union Funds. The Order does not authorise payment of compensation for the loss of animals that are visibly affected with Rabies.

8th June '96. } From the Constabulary at Oranmore, reporting that two sheep the property of John Donnellan of Prospect, and a pig the property of Wm. Burke of Kilmuirin, which were bitten on the 19th ultimo by a dog supposed to be rabid, having shown symptoms of rabies, were on this date shot by the Police at the request of the owners.

The Vet. Inspector reported that he had no doubt but the two sheep were rabid, but he doubted that the pig was affected with rabies.

Order. The persons reported by the Police for allowing their dogs to be at large unmuzzled, to be prosecuted. The Collector to attend at Oranmore, & the Clerk at Cahoon P.O. courts.

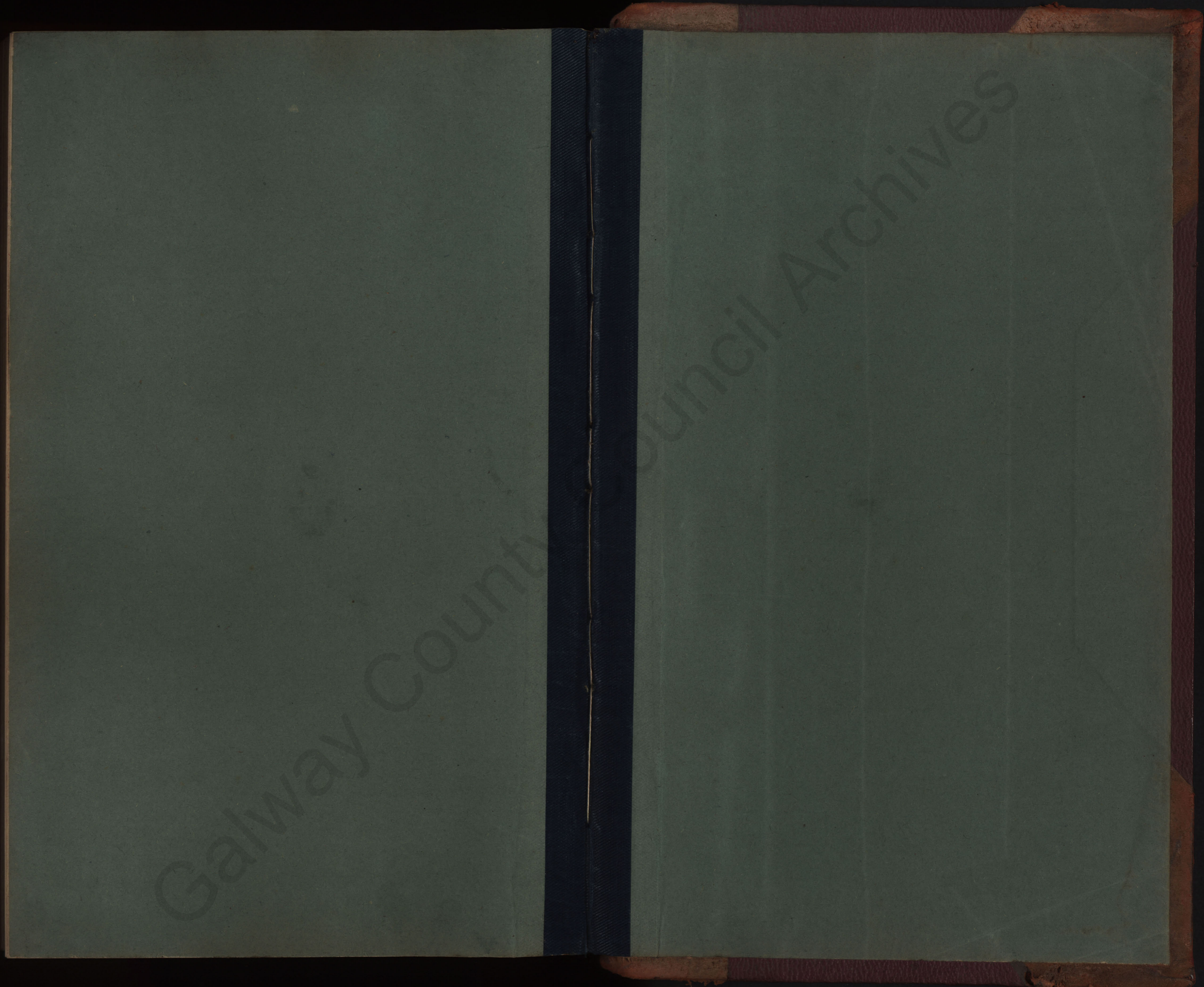
