 warded in the case of Peter Murphy who was  
 absent from school on 18 days during the  
 quarter ended the 30<sup>th</sup> inst. on the plea of illness.  
*The Guardians imposed fines of 6<sup>th</sup> a day for absence  
 from school on the foster parents as a punishment.  
 Order. The Committee to be informed of the necessity of for-  
 warding a medical certificate when sickness is  
 assigned as a cause of absence.*

Dist.; & stating that, in view of the limitations on borrowing & capital expenditure placed on local authorities, they consider that the Guardians should arrange to postpone this project during the period of the War.

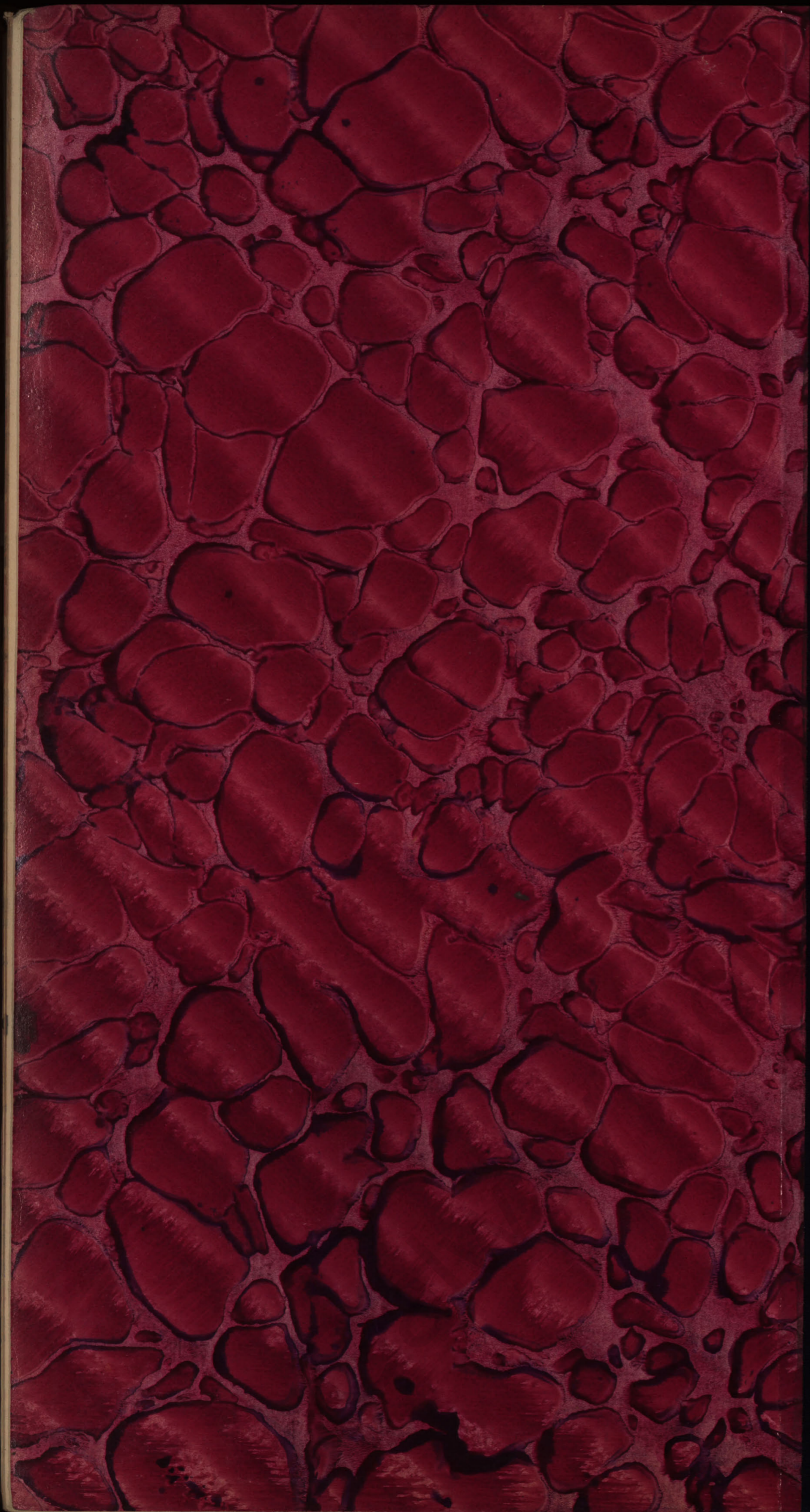

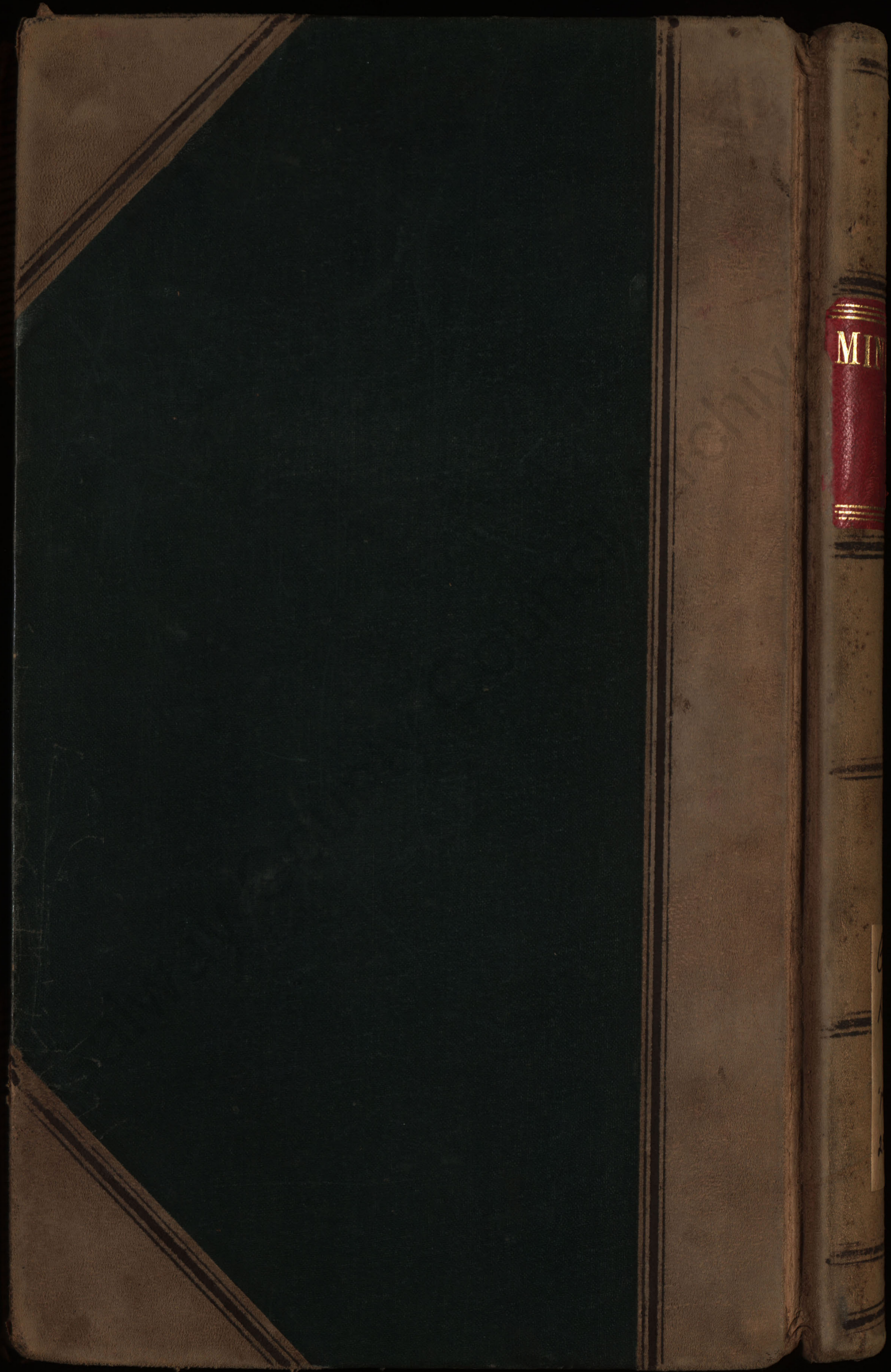
