Resolved, that one mule be purchased for £ 4. 0. 0 and the poor Law Commrs are requested to sanction it.

The Vice Guardians having had their attention drawn to the incompetency of Miss Anne Burke of Matron.

Resolved that she be called on for her resignation, and that the Clerk advertise for competent persons willing to undertake the duties, proposals to be considered 17th Inst, to which day the appointment of Matron is postponed.

The attention of the Vice Guardians having been called to the fact that the time named by Mr Jolly Solicitor to the Board for the settlement of the various Suits instituted against parties in this Union for amount of Poor Rates and by them expired two months ago.

Resolved that the Clerk call on Mr Jolly for an explanation.

The Master reported that Pat Molloy & John Hannen two paupers had left the Work House with the Union Clothes and having been pursued and brought to him they expressed a wish to leave the House he discharged them.

He also reported that Pat Melvin had absconded with the Union Clothing and that a Warrant had been issued for his apprehension.

The Board adjourned to Thursday the 4th Inst.
