

DRAFT DIRECTION IN THE MATTER OF SECTION 31 OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 (AS AMENDED) LOUGHREA LOCAL AREA PLAN 2024-2030

The Loughrea Local Area Plan 2024-2030 was formally made by the Elected Members of the Loughrea Municipal District on the 15th July 2024.

As required under Sections 31AO(5) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (As Amended) the Planning Authority issued notification of the Plan's adoption to the Office of the Planning Regulator (OPR). The Chief Executive also informed the OPR of the decision of the Authority not to comply with certain recommendations made in the relevant report of the OPR, together with reasons for the decision of the Authority.

On the 22nd August 2024 the Minister of State for Local Government and Planning is issued a 'Notice of Intention to issue a Direction' to the Planning Authority under Section 31 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (As Amended) ('the Act'). The Draft Direction concerns the zoning of one parcel of land in the town. Interested parties are advised that these matters, in accordance with Section 31(6) of the Act, shall not have effect, notwithstanding their inclusion in the Plan as adopted by the Council and pending the issuing of the Minister's Final Direction.

The Draft Direction sets out the following:

- (i) Reinstate the following zoning objectives and associated text consistent with the recommendation of the Chief Executive's Report on the material alterations, and delete the following Material Alteration from the adopted Local Area Plan:
 - Material Alteration MA35 from the adopted Local Area Plan - i.e. the subject lands revert to unzoned from Community Facilities.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

- i. The Local Area Plan includes a material alteration to the draft Local Area Plan to zone land as Community Facilities located on the far side of the N65 national road with no existing or planned access by walking, cycling or public transport, from Loughrea, inconsistent with the objectives of the RSES and County Development Plan for sustainable growth which prioritises connectivity by way of safe, secure walking and cycling routes and public transport (RPO 6.30 of the RSES and County Development Plan Policy Objectives PM 4 and PM 6), and supports the provision of pedestrian and cycling infrastructure for shorter local journeys (County Development Plan Policy Objectives GCTPS 4 and WC 4).
- ii. The Local Area Plan includes a material alteration to zone land as Community Facilities adjoining the N65 national road which is inconsistent with RPO 6.5 of the RSES and Policy Objective NR 1 of the County Development Plan to protect the strategic capacity and safety of the national roads network and associated national road junctions, and fails to have regard to sections 2.4 and 2.7 of the Spatial Planning and National Roads Guidelines for Planning Authorities (2012).
- iii. The Local Area Plan has not been made in a manner consistent with, and has failed to implement, the recommendations of the Office of the Planning Regulator under section 31AO of the Act.
- iv. The Minister is of the opinion that the Local Area Plan as made is inconsistent with the objectives of the Development Plan of the area, which is a requirement of section 19(2) of the Act.
- v. The Minister is of the opinion that the Local Area Plan as made is not consistent with the objectives of the RSES, contrary to section 19(2) and section 27(1) of the Act.
- vi. The Minister is of the opinion that the Local Area Plan as made is not consistent with National Policy Objective 27 of the National Planning Framework.
- vii. The Minister is of the opinion that the Local Area Plan as made fails to set out an overall strategy for the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
- viii. The Local Area Plan is not in compliance with the requirements of the Act.

Draft Direction-Formal Public Consultation:

In accordance with the requirements of section 31(7) of the Act, the Planning Authority will commence a period of public consultation on the Minister's Notice of Intention to issue a Direction for a period of 2 weeks between the 29th August 2024 and 12th September 2024 inclusive, during which time a copy of the Draft Ministerial Direction may be inspected at the following locations:

Chief Executive's Report

This Report must then be furnished to the Office of the Planning Regulator, the Elected Members and the Minister for Local Government and Planning.

Please note that observations or submission will be made public on the Council's website and at the offices of Galway County Council and will also form part of the statutory Chief Executive's Report subsequently published on Galway County Council website. The details including the names of those making submissions may be shared with relevant Council and Government Departments or their agents involved in the process and may form part of reports linked to the making of any Direction.

Dréacht-Treoir - Comhairleachán Poiblí Foiminiúil:

De réir ceanglais Alt 31(7) an Acht, cuirfidh an tÚdarás Pleanaí tú le tréimhse chomharrúcháin phobill ar Fhógra an Aire a bhfuil sé ar intinn aige Treoir a Eisiúint ar reacht tréimhse 2 sheachtaid idir an 29 Lúnasa 2024 agus an 12 Meán Fómhair 2024 agus na dtaisín sín san áireamh, féadfar cíp de Dhreacht-Treoir ón Aire a iníorchadh sna láithreacha seo a leanas:

- Ar an suíomh seo – feach atá náisiúntaí air a thaoibh na láimhe deise den leathanach seo.
- Ag ofigí na Comhairle seo a leanas le linn gnáthairreanta oflige (9am-4pm, Luan go húine):
- Ofigí pleanaí Chomhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe, Áras an Chontae, Cnoc na Radharc, Gaillimh,

Tá na nithe seo a leanas leagtha amach sa Dréacht-threoir:

- (i) Na cuspóirí crosaithí seo a leanas agus an téacs gaoilínar a athbhunú i gcomháití le moladh Thuarascáil an Phromhfeidhmeannaigh ar na hathrúthe ábhartha, agus an Athrú Ábhartha seo a leanas a scios ón bPlean Limistéir Áitiúil ar gacadh i leis;

- Athrú Ábhartha M/435 ón bPlean Limistéir Áitiúil ar gacadh leis - i. na talte ébhartha a athrú ó thailte crosaithí mar Áiseanna Pobail go talte nach bhfuil crosaithí.

RÁITEAS AR FHÁTHAINN

- i. Tá athrú ábhartha sa Dréachiphean Ceantair Áitiúil chun talamh a chriosú mar Shaoisridi Pobail atá suite a an taobh thall de phromhfeidhmeannaigh ar na dtaisín sín aon rochtain reatha nó pleannfáid do shíoll rothlochtaí ná d'fhompar poiblí ó Bhaile Locha Riach, rud nach bhfuil sé teacht le cuspóirí an Straitéis Spásúil agus Easchamhach Régiumach (SSE5) agus le Phlean Forbartha an Contae maidir le fás ionpair phobill (RPO 6.30) den Straitéis Régiumach Spásúil agus Cuspóirí Beartais Phlean Forbartha Contae PM 4 agus PM 6), agus tacáinn sé le soláthar bonmeagair do chloiste agus do rothaithe ar thuraíais atíulla níos giorra (Cuspóirí Beartais Phlean Forbartha an Chontae GCTP5 4 agus WC 4).

- ii. Áirítear sa Phlean Ceantair Áitiúil athrú ábhartha ar thatarrn crosaithí mar Áiseanna Pobail tadlaíoch le Régiumach (RSE5) agus Cuspóirí Beartais Phlean Forbartha Contae chun an acmhainch straitéiseach agus sábháilteachta bóthre náisiúnta agus acomhláí/ghaoilimhara a chosaint, agus a theipeann ar ait 2.4 agus 2.7 de na Treoiríntí um Pleanaíl Spás agus Bóthre Náisiúnta d'Údarás Pleanaí (2012).

- iii. Níor ceapadh an Plean Limistéir Áitiúil ar bhealach atá comhcheasadh le moltaí Cifí ag an Rialtora Pleanaí faoi ait 31 AOD den Acht agus níor cuireadh na moltaí i bhfeidhm.

- iv. Measamh an Aire nach bhfuil an Plean Limistéir Áitiúil faoi mar a rímeadh é ag teacht le cuspóirí Phlean Forbartha an cheantair, ar riachtanais é d'áit 19(2) den Acht.

- v. Measamh an Aire go bhfuil an Plean Ceantair Áitiúil mar atá ceaptha ar neamhfeir leis na cuspóirí Straitéis Spásúil agus Easchamhach Régiumach, contrártha d'áit 19(2) agus d'áit 27(1) den Acht.

- vi. Measamh an Aire nach bhfuil an Plean Limistéir Áitiúil mar a rímeadh é ag teacht le Cuspóirí Beartais Náisiúnta 27 den Chreat Náisiúnta Pleanaí.

- vii. Measamh an Aire nach legtar smach a phlean Limistéir Áitiúil, mar a rímeadh é, straitéis fhionnlán do phleanáil chui agus d'fhogairt inbhianaithe an cheantair.

- viii. Ni chomhionann an Plean Limistéir Áitiúil ceangalais an Achta.
